All containers need new potting soil each year. Plants will otherwise fail in the heat

- Heavier doses of Miracid (1 tablespoon/gallon) will correct yellowing plants faster.
- Lower doses of Miracid (1 teaspoon/gallon) can be used for a mixture of plant types.
- Most of our plants are "**Self-Cleaning**" by rain and wind
- The only plants that need "**Dead Heading**" **Verbena and Geraniums**

Neutral Basic Plant: Peters or Miracle-Gro MIXED with water (1.5 tbsp / 2 gal H₂O)

Dry Side Growers

- Fuchsia (lower doses)
- Impatiens (lower doses)
- Moss Roses, Mezoo
- Dragon/Big Begonias
- Vegetables in Garden
- Zinnias
- Geraniums
- Euphorbia

Moist Growers

- Alyssum
- Coleus
- Dahlia
- Lantana
- Lobelia (lower doses)

Iron Type Acidic Plants: Miracid-type Feeders (scoop included, 1.5 tbsp in 2 gal H₂O)

Less Frequent Waterings

(Acidic feeders but dry between applications)

- Ivy Geraniums
- Hydrangea's
- Specialty Salvia
- Perennial Ground Cover
- Vinca

More Frequent Waterings

(Acidic feeders staying evenly moist)

- All Petunias
- Calibrachoa
- Verbena
- Bacopa
- Mandevilla
- Hibiscus
