HANGING BASKET CARE SHEET

- ★ *Water enough for just a drip through the bottom in order to provide enough water, approximately 1gal.*
- ★ *Hang baskets at edge of overhangs with 12"-18" hook /chain so the sky light hits the top of the foliage.*
- ★ *Continuous waterings or heavy rains leach key nutrients from basket. Replace with MirAcid May - Sept.*
- ★ *June - August require more feed. UP your feeding schedule to twice per week, spaced out.*
- ★ *Check the basket water weight by lifting... Heavy means it has water.*
- ★ *Check color of leaves... Yellow means it needs feeding! Lush green is healthy*

Petunia Combo, Calibrachoa Combo, Can't Decide Combo, Hummingbird Stews

- **Light:** Sky Exposure is critical. Can take direct sun up to 9 hours.
- **Moisture:** Prefers evenly moist soil with typical waterings 1x daily.
- **Fertilizer:** 1x week MirAcid @ 1.5 TBLS/2 gal water. Feeding during cold damages roots.

Double Shade Impatiens Combo, Fuchsia, Non-Stop Begonias

- **Light:** North or East Side, can take Western exposure. Provide an area with partial sunlight. Prefer stress free areas with some sun protection
- **Moisture:** Temperature dependent, allow soil to dry between waterings. This helps force flowers. Check Water Weight. Hot months; 1x / morning
- **Fertilizer:** 1x week MirAcid @ 2 tsp/2 gal water. Feeding during cold damages roots.

Vacation Combinations & Geraniums

- **Light:** Semi to FULL Sun. Takes HOT temperatures well. East, West or South.
- **Moisture:** Wilting seldom damages. Prefers soil to dry between waterings. Time between waterings is dependent on weather. Check weight.
- **Fertilizer:** 1x week MirAcid @ 1.5 TBLS/2 gal water. Feeding during cold damages roots.

New Guinea Impatiens & SUNpatiens

- **Light:** Partial Sun & Shade or just sky exposure is best. North, East, SUNpatiens can take Western exposure.
- **Moisture:** DO NOT let wilt... DAMAGES plant. 1x / morning watering. On warm or windy days these may need extra watering.
- **Fertilizer:** 1x week MirAcid @ 1.5 TBLS/2 gal water. Feeding during cold damages roots.

Porch Potatoes / Textured Foliage

- **Light:** Flexible - Low light (under structure) to 6 hours direct sun.
- **Moisture:** Low light areas - allow drying between watering.
- **Fertilizer:** 1x week MirAcid @ 1.5 TBLS/2 gal water. Feeding during cold damages roots.
